This week our 3rd through 8th grade students will be taking the Applied Skills portion of ISTEP. Once the booklets are returned to CTB, each answer will be evaluated and assigned a score. These scores will be combined with the students' scores on the Multiple Choice portion (taken in late April/early May) to determine an overall score for each content area. The scoring process typically takes a couple of months, but because this spring test is still relatively new, we are not entirely sure when scores will be returned to us. Once we do receive the scores, you will receive a copy, and we will schedule an information meeting to review the score reports.
